A Walk to Remember

Introduction: A Walk to Remember was a heart capturing movie of a young love that develops between the rebel senior Landon and the baptist minister's daughter Jamie. Through their relationship she helps him become a better man and they fall in love. Jamie shares with him some things she would like to accomplish in her life and he begins to make them happen. She tells him that she has leukemia which devastates Landon. He proposes to her and they eventually get married at her mother's church that she had always dreamed . . . it was her "Walk to Remember." As moving as this story is, the Bible has a greater walk down the aisle. . . it is a walk of uniting with Christ and having the burning passion of love and faithfulness to Jesus and his kingdom.

Text: Luke 24:13-35, 44-48, 2 Timothy 1:5-10

Discussion:

1. Icebreaker: Tell of the time that God saved you? Write/Discuss how you felt about your new faith in Jesus.
2. Luke 24:32. When was the last time you felt like these two guys? What was it that set these guys on fire?
3. When the two men encountered Jesus, they could not keep it to themselves; they immediately told the disciples. Why did they do this? What motivates you to share your faith?
4. Luke 24:44-48. Who did Jesus say that the Old Testament was about? What did he tell them to do? What does he tell us to do?
5. Read 2 Timothy 1:5 & 2 Timothy 3:14-15. Who made an eternal investment and impact in the life of Timothy? How did they make their impact on Timothy? How can we duplicate what they did and why is it important to do so?
6. Parents have a huge responsibility in laying a solid foundation of faith in the lives of their children. Read Proverbs 1:8-9. What does this say that the Father and Mother should be doing? If you are a parent, how well are you teaching and instructing? If you are a son/daughter, how well are you listening?
7. The book of Proverbs are filled with wisdom and insight into living a life pleasing to the Lord. The message spoke on several points that are made in the book of Proverbs. Search the book of Proverbs and find scripture evidence for the following teaching points.
 - Fear God
 - Love instruction and correction
 - Strong work ethic and the rebuke of laziness
 - Importance of character and integrity
 - Be a giver and not a taker
 - Never mistreat someone or take advantage of someone
 - High moral standards and true friendship
8. Read 2 Timothy 1:6-10 Paul encourages Timothy to fan into the flame that is in him . . . keep the fire burning hot for Jesus. How can you make sure that the fire of your faith remains aflame?

Think About it:

Lois and Eunice lived a life that made an impact on their son and grandson. They are recorded in sacred scripture for their walk of faith. They truly had a "Walk to Remember." If we live our life in faithfulness to the Lord and impart his good news to others, then we will have a "Walk to Remember." We will have that life that will impact the generations behind us and lay the foundation of faith that will lead them to Jesus so they can begin their own walk of faith.

How do you want to be remembered? Begin making a list of the faith steps in your life that you need to take to fan into flame your passion to follow Jesus with complete surrender. Commit each day to walk with Jesus and please him in all you do.
