



The Revelation of Jesus, Alpha and Omega

Introduction: Jesus is coming to make all things new and He will accomplish all! The last chapter of Revelation guarantees that Jesus is victorious and will bring His kingdom. The call to the believer is to keep their eyes on the truth of God's word and remain faithful to Him.

Text: Revelation 22

Discussion:

1. Have you ever showed up late or left early and not caught all of a movie? How did it make you feel? What did you miss out on?
2. Why is it important to understand the centrality of Christ in the entire Bible? What does it mean that Jesus is the Alpha and Omega? Rev. 22:13.
3. What are the similarities of Genesis 2 and Revelation 22?
4. How did man get placed in the garden in Genesis 2? How does man get placed in the garden in Revelation 22?
5. What cost Adam and Eve the privilege of being in God's presence in the garden? (Gen. 3)
6. What was the consequence of Adam and Eve's disobedience?
7. What is the hope of Gen. 3:15?
8. The water in the garden of Eden produced the nourishment for the trees to bear fruit. Read John 7:37-38. What does this speak about what Jesus brings?
9. Read Acts 2:23. Was the cross of Christ an afterthought? How does this connect with Jesus as Alpha and Omega?
10. Read John 12:23. Adam ate from the wrong tree and brought death. Jesus came and became the curse and was nailed to a tree. Jesus—now becomes the tree of life that offers the fruit of salvation to all who come to Him. Write/Discuss about the amazing sacrifice of Jesus.
11. Rev. 22:1-5 What will the new garden be like for the believer? Discuss/write about being eternally in the presence of God.
12. Revelation 22:7. What must we do other than know the scripture?
13. Revelation 22:17. Write/Discuss how this verse applies to the Church, individual Christians, and those who do not yet believe in Jesus?

Think About it:

Jesus states that surely He is coming soon! The Bible is clear that there is a day coming when Jesus makes all things new and rules with His redeemed forever and ever. The world mocks and ridicules this belief and dismisses it as nonsense and even a dangerous lie. The truth of the matter is that God's word holds true over the modern man. Christ came once and He will come again. Until then, we are to follow his commands and offer the invitation for anyone who is thirsty to come and drink of the grace of the Lord Jesus.

Take time this week to think God for His mighty grace and allowing you to eat of the fruit of salvation. Walk in the awareness of those around you who may be hungry and thirsty for redemption. Read from God's word this week and obey what you read that day. Pray for those who are lost and invite them to drink the water of life that Jesus alone offers.
